Extrication and BTLs Refresher

This course will cover the tools and techniques required to remove a trapped victim from a vehicle accident. Emphasis will be placed on proper use of powered and manual rescue tools, care and treatment of patients inside the vehicle (EMT Level), vehicle designs, IMS, and safety considerations. Participants will apply these techniques in a variety of practical applications. (This course meets the vehicle extrication requirements for firefighter I certification through the Division of Fire Safety.)

This course meets the requirements for BTLs recertification. The class is taught in coordination with expert extrication instructors and paramedics.
